



Milaca Public Schools 2022-2023 World's Best Workforce Summary

District Goals for Goal Areas

A. Kindergarten Readiness Goal

- ☐ The percentage of Milaca students enrolled in Kindergarten that score at or above the Early Reading Composite Benchmark score (32) on Formative Assessment System for Teachers (FAST) reading on their entry benchmarking (fall) will increase from 60.3% in 2022-2023 to 64.0% in 2023-2024.
 - Results were 67.7% in 2020-2021, 54.4% in 2021-2022, 60.3% in 2022-2023, and 51.0% in 2023-2024
 - The goal was not met.
- ☐ The percentage of Milaca student enrolled in Kindergarten that score at or above the Early Math Composite Benchmark score (29) on Formative Assessment System for Teachers (FAST) math on their entry benchmarking (fall) will increase from 63.7% in 2022-2023 to 68.2% in 2023-2024.
 - Results were 72.6% in 2020-2021, 66.7% in 2021-2022, 63.7% in 2022-2023, and 60.0% in 2023-2024.
 - The goal was not met.

B. Third Grade Literacy Goal

- ☐ The percentage of Milaca third graders scoring proficient on the MCA III-Reading will increase from 44.0% in 2022 to at or above 63.2% in 2025.
 - Proficiency was 63.2% in 2019, 48.1% in 2021, 44.0% in 2022, 46.1% in 2023.
 - The goal is in progress

C. Achievement Gap Closure

District Reading Goals

- ☐ Milaca students in grades 3-10 who receive special education services will decrease the current achievement gap (30.5%) compared to Milaca's "All" student group. The measure used will be MCA-III Reading proficiency results.
 - The achievement gap was 34.1% in 2019, 29.1% in 2021, 30.5% in 2022, and 30.6% in 2023.
 - The goal was not met.
- ☐ Milaca students in grades 3-10 who receive free or reduced price lunch will decrease the current achievement gap (12.3%) compared to Milaca's "All" student group. The measure used will be MCA-III Reading proficiency results.
 - The achievement gap was 11.8% in 2019, 9.6% in 2021, 12.3% in 2022, and 9.7% in 2023

- The goal was met.

D. Career and College Readiness Goals

- The average ACT composite score for students who are anticipated to graduate in 2021 was 19.4. The Milaca School District will increase to an average of 19.9 for students who anticipate to graduate in 2022. This data always trends a year behind due to the release of the data by the Minnesota Department of Education.
 - The ACT Composite score for graduating class in 2019 was 19.5, in 2020 it was 19.9, in 2021 it was 19.4, and in 2022 it was 20.0.
 - Goal was met.
- The percentage of 11th graders and 12th graders at Milaca Public Schools that participate in a work-based learning experience, will be sustain at 20.1% during the 2022-2023 school year.
 - Participation was 11.6% during the 2018-2019 school year, 17.4% during the 2019-2020 school year, 15.2% during the 2020-2021 school year, 20.1% during the 2021-2022 school year, and 20.6% during the 2022-2023 school year.
 - This includes students in work skills, work experience, work release, and career and technical internships.
 - The goal was met.

E. High School Graduation Goal

- Milaca School District will increase its 4-year graduation rate from 89.4% in 2021 to above 90% in 2022.
 - The graduation rate for 2022 was 85.5%.
 - The goal was not met.
