NOTE TO SCHOOL OFFICIALS

National Federation Track and Field Rule 7-5-3. The competitor's weight shall be at or below the manufacturer's pole rating. The manufacturers must include on each pole: the pole rating that shall be a minimum of 3/4 inch in a contrasting color located within or above the top handhold position; a 1-inch circular band indicating the maximum top handhold position with the position being determined by the manufacturer. Prior to the competition the coach must verify that all of the schools pole vaulters meet these requirements.

Note: Older vaulting poles should be marked with the manufacturer's pole rating by use of an indelible marking pen in a one-inch contrasting color printed lengthwise above the hand-hold band.

MPA meet directors reserve the right, at state meets, to use this form to compare the manufacturer's pole rating and the weight of each vaulter.
