Student is due for a three year reevaluation. Do any of the following apply?

- Student is turning 6 and due for 3 year reevaluation
- Student qualifies under Developmental Delay and is turning 7 years old
- Student is in grades 7, 8, or 9 and secondary transition has not yet been assessed
- The team is considering a new category of eligibility
- The team suspects that the student has additional needs that were not identified in the most recent evaluation
- The team is considering exiting from all special education services
- An evaluation is needed in order to document medical necessity for Third Party Billing
- The Non-Evaluation process was completed the last time a 3 year reevaluation was due

4. Are additions or modifications to the student's programming needed?
5. Does the parent agree that no additional data is needed?
6. Is there documented medical necessity for Third Party Billing?
