Anne Frank Book Jacket

You will create a book jacket for <u>The Diary of Anne Frank</u>. Incorporate the following information:

Front Cover--Title and author. Draw a picture to represent the play or find a picture off the internet. Remember to write the author (Frances Goodrich and Albert Hackett) and title on the binding of the jacket.

Back Cover--Summarize the story. Make readers want to read the story. Be sure to include the beginning, middle and end in the summary. Include the main characters of the play and the main events.

Inside Front Flap--Quote three passages from the play that you think are interesting or that you think are important to the play.

Inside Back Flap--Persuade people to read the play. Tell three reasons why people your age should read it. Think about the reasons why you like it. Really try to sell the book.

Be creative with this assignment. Jazz up the front cover to attract readers. Above all, be neat. Your written work can be word processed and then cut out and glued to your book jacket.

**Remember that the front and back covers will be one document with smaller margins and your inside front and back flaps will be another document with columns.

This assignment is worth 100 points. You will be graded on the following:

- 1. Accuracy and completeness of information
- 2. Neatness
- 3. Creativity
