

Interpreting a student score report in JMC (for grades 7 - 12)

X	exempt score	This assignment is not required for this student. It does not count for or against the current grade.
LX	<i>Do not use this code</i>	
LI	late included score	This assignment is considered late, and is factored into the student's grade as a 0%. Late assignments may still be turned in to the teacher for partial or full credit pending teacher late work policy.
M	missing exempt score	This assignment has not been turned in and is not factored into the current grade. This is an assignment that needs to be completed and the due date has passed.
MI	missing included score	This assignment has not been turned in, and is factored into the student's grade as a 0%. This is an assignment that needs to be completed and may change to a "late" assignment with potential for point deductions for lateness based on the teacher late work policy.
HI	handed in exempt score	The student has turned in this assignment and it is waiting for grading by the teacher. This score is not factored in to the current grade.
P	pending	The student has turned in this assignment, but needs to edit, make corrections, or complete in some way before a grade will be given. This score is not factored in to the current grade.
0	zero score	This assignment earned a score of 0 or was never turned in and is no longer eligible for any points.
<i>left blank</i>	no information provided	<i>Within 24 hours of a deadline, blanks in score reports should be filled in with either a numerical score or a code from the JMC legend (above). The Extra Credit category is an exception and activities in an Extra Credit category may be left blank if the student did not complete those assignments.</i>
