- 3) the name of the symbol you chose (i.e. teddy bear, coffee mug, etc)
- 4) a description of why you chose that symbol and how it represents the section
- Each symbol must be printed out or neatly drawn.
- You are not required to use additional materials but may if you wish.
- Your must have a cover page that includes
 - a title for your project,
 - the title of the novel (Out of the Dust),
 - and your name.

Put thought into the **colors** (or lack of colors) that you use on your scrapbook pages. Make sure that your scrapbook is neat and visual. You may bind it any functional way that you wish. I encourage you to be creative and think outside of the box with this project.
