# Create a Hypothesis

Describe what you expect to happen BEFORE we go out into the woods.

- \* Explain how you will use your research to make an educated guess about how you think your experiment in the woods would turn out.
- \* Explain how you rely on your past experiences, too.

# Procedure

- You will
  - Set up your shelter,
  - Start a fire,
  - Provide yourself water to drink.

#### Procedure Continued

- Take photos.
- You can do the different stages of completion of your shelter, fire, water.

#### **Materials**

- ☐ Make a complete list of everything you will bring with you into the woods (including what you wear).
- ☐ You can have up to five items that you could walk into the woods with. You must carry them on your person -- not in a bag of any type.
- ☐ Tell how many and how much of each object used.
- ☐ The hatchet is NOT one of the five.
- □Striker is one.
