Learning Readiness

Labeled Supplies - please write your child's name in permanent marker:

- 1 box of Classic washable Crayola markers
- 1 pocket folder (with 3 hole fasteners in middle used for their monthly calendar)
- 1 backpack large enough to fit a pocket folder, snack, outdoor clothing and a cold lunch (if needed)
- 1 water bottle that will stay at school
- Gym shoes that will stay at school
- Beach towel OR blanket that fits into a 2 gal. jumbo Ziploc
- Extra clothes - including socks and underwear (please put in Ziploc to stay at school)

Classroom Supplies - don't need to be labeled:

- 1 box of glue sticks (disappearing purple Large or Medium if possible)
- 3 pack dry erase markers (any color)
- 1 pkg unscented baby wipes

Monday/Thursday Class (only if in this class)

- 1 box of **5 oz.** Dixie cups OR 1 box of gallon Ziplocs

Wednesday/Friday Class (only if in this class)

- 1 box of Kleenex OR 1 box of quart Ziplocs

Kindergarten

Your child will need the following items on the first day of school. Please label the following items by writing your child's name with permanent marker.

- 2 - pocket folders (Plastic folders if possible- they last MUCH longer! ☺)
- 1 - plastic pencil box
- 1 - scissors
- 1 - composition notebook (This will be used for our writing journal.)

Kindergarten (continued)

- 1 - towel for rest time (Towels are much easier than folding mats.)
- 1 - 1 pair of tennis shoes to keep in school (for gym).
- 1 - set of extra clothes (including underwear and socks) Please put all clothing in a labeled Ziploc bag!
- 1-water bottle (Please send filled with your child on the first day of school!)

The following items do not need to be labeled:

- 1 - back pack
- 2 - 24-count **Classic Colors** crayons
- 10 - #2 pencils (Ticonderoga is a good brand.)
- 2 - pink erasers
- 2 - 12 packs of glue sticks
- 1 - box of markers
- 4 - dry erase markers
- 1- box of Kleenex

1st Grade

- Backpack (no wheels please)
- 1 spiral notebook
- Scissors
- Pencils

- 4 dry erase markers for white boards
- 3 sturdy folders for daily use
- Ear/head phones

- * Box of tissues (to share with class)

- * Gallon sized Ziploc bags
- * Extra snack items (crackers/pretzels) for the children who forget a snack.

Students will need to replace supplies during the year. It is best to stock up in the fall when items are cheaper and easier to find, and then send to school as needed.

2nd Grade

- 2 pencil sharpeners
- Erasers (long rectangular type or pencil top)
- Markers (10 pack of Crayola classic colors)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- Glue sticks (3 sticks)
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 two-pocket folder (take home folder)
- 2 notebooks- wide ruled (Your child may need 1 or 2 additional notebooks later in the school year so you may want to buy extra now.)
- 4 dry erase markers (any color)
- Pencils - **enough for the entire school year**
- Headphones (for computer use)
- Gym shoes to keep at school (they do not need to be new, but clean)
