




Description: This class is designed for the Beginner through AD-VANCED level photographer. Photographers who want a better understanding of how their interchangeable Digital Single Lens Reflex camera and/or their Interchangeable Lens Mirrorless Camera works and how to apply that knowledge when taking pictures.

The class will concentrate on the basic mechanics on how and why a digital camera forms an image. It will give the participant an opportunity to improve their photography skills through six weekly classroom sessions & three optional weekend workshops.

The course will meet weekly on Wednesday evenings starting April 11th and run for six consecutive weeks. The optional workshops meet on various weekends for those students who wish to expand their photography knowledge via a "hands on" approach.

The course includes one copy of Bryan Peterson's "Understanding Photography Field Guide". The participant must have access to their own digital camera, as well as a computer to transfer images to a USB 2.0 flash drive or an email account to turn in assign-

ments.
