#### What is Help Me Grow?

Help Me Grow is the state's referral system for infants, toddlers and preschoolers that may have developmental delays or a disability.

#### Learn age-specific milestones.

Visit www.helpmegrowmn.org to view milestones for children. There is a short video along with key milestones broken into the areas of Moving-Physical Development; Talking-Communication & Language Development; Interacting-Social Emotional Development; and Thinking-Cognitive Development.

#### Make a referral.

If you are concerned with a child's development, you are encouraged to make a referral. This includes parents, childcare providers, doctors, nurses, grandparents and other relatives, public health, etc. The process is easy and can be done online at <a href="https://www.helpmegrowMN.org">www.helpmegrowMN.org</a> or by calling 1-866-693-4769. Once a referral is made, it will be directed to the child's local school district.






## + Outdoor Classroom +

The district has prioritized student safety and learning. All students have 1:1 devices and the district has installed many outdoor internet access points. Adding the Outdoor Classroom will make it possible for classes to be held outside. In addition to providing a shade system, the Outdoor Classroom is also handicap accessible. We hope the community will enjoy it as much as we will!









### **Minnesota Permit to Carry Class**

This class meets Minnesota's requirement to receive instruction in the fundamentals of pistol use, and the fundamental legal aspects of pistol possession, carry, and use, including self-defense and the restrictions on the use of deadly force. Students will also be required to complete a live fire qualification exercise.

Students will need to bring a hand gun and at least 50 round of ammunition. All other material will be provided.

Cost: \$100

Dates/Times: January 18 5:30pm-9:30pm & January 19 3pm-dark

Shooting portion to take place outdoors on January 19, so dress accordingly.



### HIIT Cardio Fitness with Tyra

A little about me- I have recently been trained and certified in teaching HIIT

classes through Fit and Fire Studio in Aberdeen, SD. I am so excited to be able to bring back what I have learned through this awesome program to our community.

What to expect- Instructor led work out classes combining strength and cardio training, alternating high intensity exercises with low intensity exercises. Classes are 60 minutes long, beginning with 5-10 minutes of stretches and a
 warm up workout, followed by 35-40 minute main
 workout, and ends with a 5-10 minute burnout. Every work
 out is different each day. These classes are effective for weight loss, improving energy, strength, and endurance.



Minimum of 5 for a class, max of 20. Registration is done through the Spond app. Price per class is \$5.50. Payments can be made per class or a "punch card" of 10 classes for \$55.
Cash, check, or Venmo is accepted.
