## Established tie breaker formula for Divisional Playoff Seeding:

1. If there is a tie between two teams, head-to-head competition will be the tie breaker.
2. If there are more than two teams tied for playoff qualification, pool records will be the first tie breakers. Pool records will be the win/loss record among the tied qualifying teams only. If this process leaves two teams still tied, revert back to \#1 (head-to-head competition).
3. If pool records do not break the tie among three or more teams, then matching teams' records against teams with a higher league record, starting with the highest ranked team and matching one lower team ranking a team at a time. If this process leaves two teams still tied, revert back to \#1 (head-to-head competition).
4. If \#3 does not break the tie among three or more teams, then matching teams' records against teams with a lower league record, starting with the highest ranked team and matching one lower team ranking a team at a time. If this process leaves two teams still tied, revert back to \#1 (head-to-head competition).
5. Coin toss will be used to break the tie.
