- All eligible teams will be seeded according to win percentage in all division games.

## Division 4 games will have the following limits on play:

- No more than five runs may be scored per inning with the exception of the seventh inning where an unlimited number of runs may be scored by either team.
- All games will be limited to two hours in length. The home team shall record the exact starting time in the scorebook. The umpire shall verify the starting time with the home team scorer. In the event an inning exceeds the two-hour limit, the inning shall be completed and the game ended assuming the score is not tied.
- If the score is tied after 2 hours then the international tie breaker rule shall be imposed.
- The 10 -run rule shall be in effect after 5 innings.
- Umpires and coaches are requested to document the length of the game in hours and minutes.
- Umpires shall carry a set of these rules with them, as should all Division 4 coaches.
