Mission Statement

The purpose of the St. Charles Hall of Fame is to honor those people who have made a significant contribution to St. Charles High School Athletics and Activities as a coach, director, player, performer, administrator, or community member.

Nominations

Anyone interested in nominating someone for consideration for the Hall of Fame should fill out the nomination form as completely as possible. This form will be available on the school's website. Any nominees not selected will remain on file for future consideration.

Process/Timelines

- Nominations will be accepted at any time throughout the year.
- Deadline for nominations in a given year is May 1st.
- The selection committee will meet after May 1st.
- Select and inform recipients by July 1st.
- Awards presentation will be at a football game or its own event in the fall. The first option will be the homecoming game, but the top priority is to have the recipients present.

Criteria

• Athletes or Performers

- **o** Must be an alumnus of St. Charles High School.
- o Must have earned at least one varsity letter.
- o Character, citizenship, and academic performance during and after high school will be a consideration.
- o Nominees are eligible for consideration 10 years after graduation.
- Excellence in achievement during the years at SCHS are the main focus, however, future accomplishments may also be considered.

Coaches and Directors

- Must have coached or directed at St. Charles for at least 15 years or at least 20 seasons.
- Priority is given to coaches or directors who are retired, but a current coach or director is eligible for nomination and selection.
- o Demonstration of high character and a purposeful career will be a top consideration.
- o No member of the selection committee will be considered while serving on the selection committee.
- o Important factors to consider when selecting a coach or director:
 - Purposeful and Transformational leadership style.
 - Record and team success while coaching at St. Charles High School.
 - Overall quality of the program and performances while in the leadership role.
 - Overall contribution to the St. Charles High School Athletic/Activities Department.

Community Members

- For those individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the St. Charles Athletic or Activity Programs.
- o The length of time as a contributor will be considered.
- o Priority will be given to those in a volunteer position for many years.
- o Demonstration of good character and a positive overall contribution will be considered.
- o No member of the selection committee is eligible while serving on the committee.

Teams

Teams that have had significant accomplishments, not necessarily championship teams.

o Ten years must have passed before a team can be nominated.

Multiple Categories

- o A person may be selected while considering their contributions in multiple categories listed above.
- A person can only be inducted one time, however, they may be considered for significant contributions across the different categories.

• Selection Committee

- Activities Director Chair
- High School Principal or designee
- o Staff member representing music or the performing arts
- Current coach of a female sport (1 or 2)
- Current coach of a male sport (1 or 2)
- o Community Members (3 or 4), preferably SCHS graduates or longtime residents
- The Hall of Fame will have a maximum of six inductees the first year. Every subsequent year there will be a maximum of four inductees. There is no maximum or minimum number of inductees allowed from each category.

Recipients

- Lifetime pass to SCHS events
- Plaque on the wall or other display
- Website display of Hall of Fame
- Other media promotion during year of induction
