During a College Literature course this week, students collected evidence at the Bird Trail to learn more about Transcendentalism.

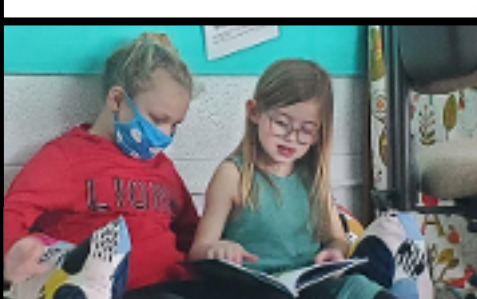
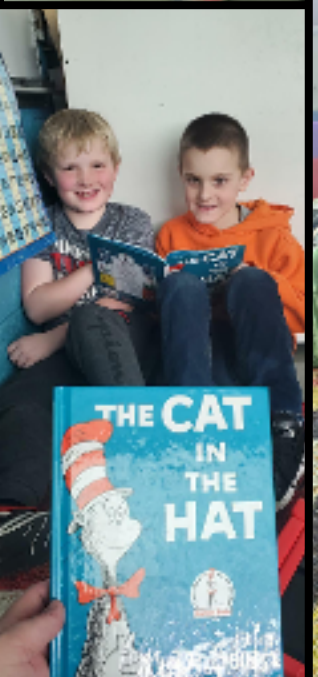
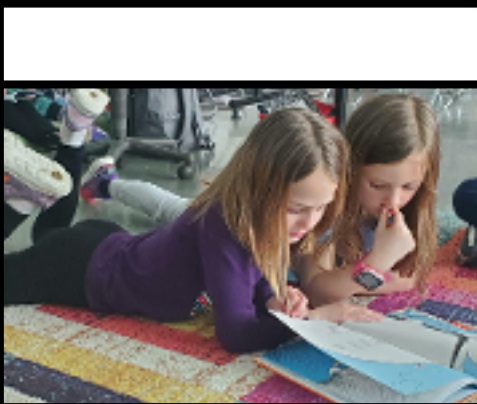
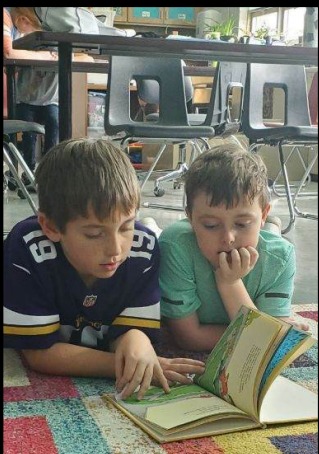
READ ACROSS AMERICA
