**NOTE**: There will NOT be regular school for elementary students (K-5) during Fall Assessment Days: Tuesday, September 6 & Wednesday, September 7 Elementary (K-5) first day of classes will be Thursday, September 8. If you do not attend an assessment for your child(ren), they will be counted absent.

# **FOOD SERVICE**

Just a reminder, school meals will NOT be free for ALL during the 2022-2023 school year. Good news, Free and Reduced meal eligibility has been extended to those students/



families that are Medicaid eligible. The District has received that information directly from DHS, as well as SNAP and other categorically eligible areas. If eligible, you would have received a notice of Direct Certification at the end of July, you do not need to complete a Free and Reduced Meal Application for the 2022-2023 school year. Your child/children may also qualify additional benefits such as the Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) which is a federal temporary emergency nutrition benefit that is loaded onto electronic cards for families to purchase food.

Your application also helps the school qualify for education funds, grants and discounts.
