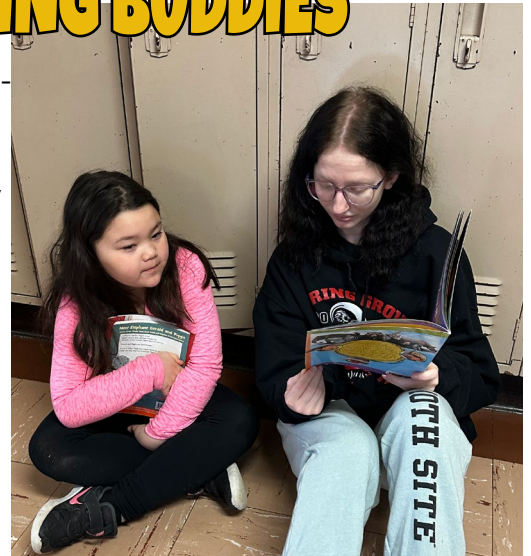

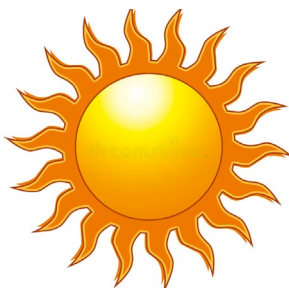
STUDENTS, are you looking for a summer job?

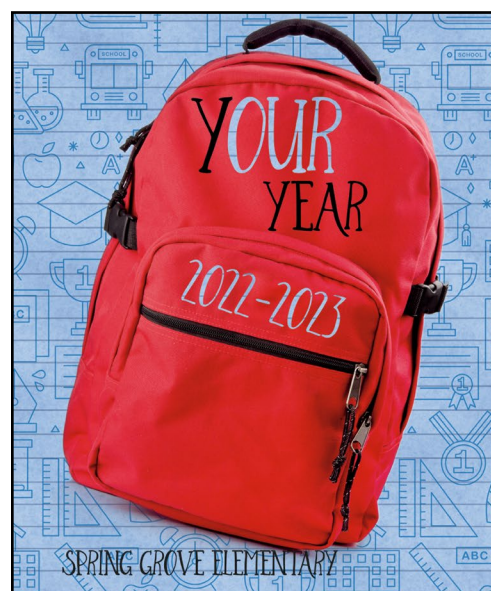

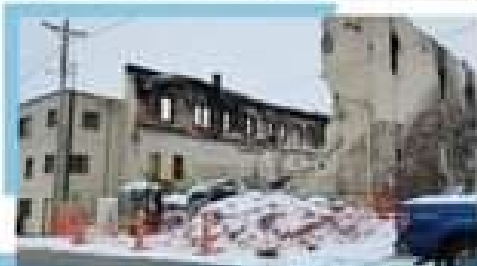
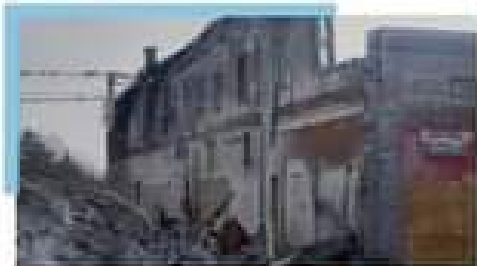
