Part of the planning will explore how, and if, these updates will occur in collaboration with the vision and potential projects identified by the Spring Grove 2030 committee. These updates will serve our community for generations; therefore, it is important that we get the plan right!

It is also important to district leadership and the school board that the community has a voice in the planning process. Our goal is to have a core group of citizens that are representative of the community that:

- Gain a deep understanding of the needs of the district
- Learn about the financing options for school projects
- Provide input on potential projects' design and features
- Explore collaboration opportunities with the Spring Grove 2030 projects
- Take feedback from the greater community and provide a recommendation to the school board on projects to pursue


