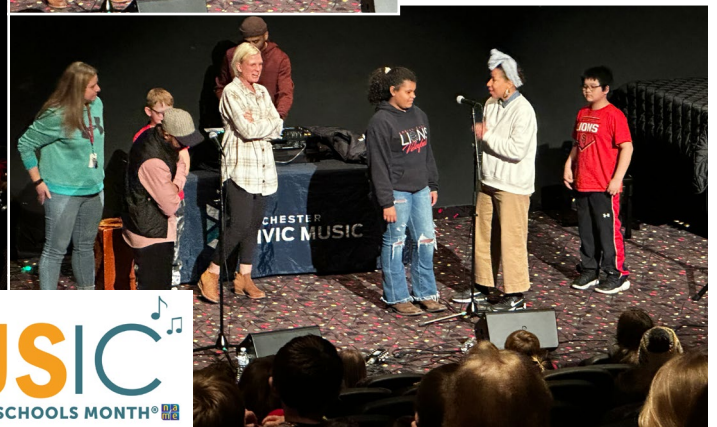
# 100 DAYS OF SCHOOL - MORE 100 YEAR OLDS -

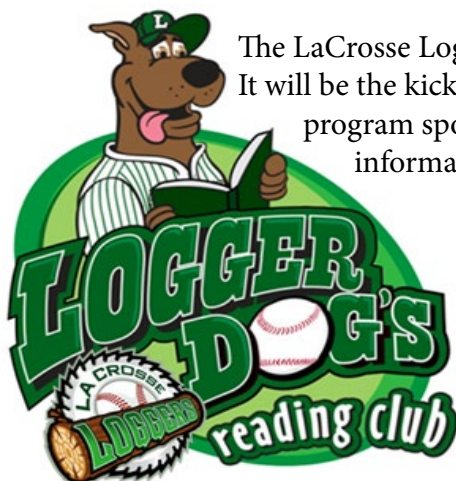
