FREE SCHOOL MEALS FOR KIDS BILL SIGNED INTO LAW

Governor Walz signed the Free School Meals for Kids bill on Friday, March 17, 2023. The Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) is excited to implement this program for our students in Minnesota. This legislation provides state reimbursement for a free breakfast and lunch to all students at schools participating in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and the School Breakfast Program (SBP). The Free School Meals for Kids Program will start on July 1, 2023*. *in Spring Grove it will be the beginning of the 2023-24 school year, there is no summer food service




March 29. It was a rousing good time, and after 28 minutes of intense playing it ended in a tie 37 - 37.

Free Teen Car Control Clinic

April 29 or 30 from 7:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m.

Gundersen La Crosse Campus, Parking Lot F Breakfast and lunch will be provided

The clinic teaches fundamentals of vehicle control during classroom sessions and behind the wheel exercises. Teens will leave with an increased sense of confidence in their ability to handle their vehicle as well as increased awareness of hazards on the road. We require that a parent/guardian attend the course with the licensed teen (16-19 years of age). You must use your own vehicle for the driving portion of the course.

A \$50 deposit is required at registration, which will be refunded in full after completion of the program.
