553 ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY POLICY (LOCAL POLICY)

Academic eligibility rules apply for the following activities:

- 1. All Minnesota State High School League Activities
- 2. Any Spring Grove Drama Productions
- 3. Any Spring Grove Music Performance
- 4. Any FFA Sponsored Activities

During the School Year

Students will be evaluated every two weeks. If after two weeks a student is failing one class, he/she will be warned and will be expected to bring the grade up to passing (D-). If the student is still failing that class for the next consecutive reporting period, then the student will be declared ineligible for a two-week duration and will continue to be ineligible until he/she is passing that class.

Quarter Grades

If a student is failing a class at the end of a quarter, that student will be ineligible for two weeks. Students will be put on academic probation if they have an incomplete at the end of the first quarter. After two weeks, if the student has not made up the work to improve the grade to passing, that student will be ineligible.
