We are excited to announce that we have a Youth Mental Health Navigator assigned to our school district for the next two years. This position is funded by the Greater Mankato United Way so there is no cost for our school district.

The mental health navigator builds relationships with community agencies and service providers and has a knowledge base on which provider would be the best fit for each student and their family. As a school district, there are many times that we know a student needs mental health support and we struggle to get the family connected because we don't have the connections. This position will greatly enhance our ability to make connections for our students and families.
