Expectations

Flexible Learning Day Goal

- St. Clair's Flexible Learning Day aims to make days when school is canceled educationally productive for both students and teachers.
- Students and teachers will use developmentally appropriate resources to communicate and engage students in work that addresses curriculum and standards set for the district.

What Will Teachers Do?

- On a Flexible Learning Day, **teachers** will:
 - Post their Flexible Learning assignment/activity on their Google Classroom by 10:00 am
 - Be available via email between 10:00am-3:00pm for students to ask questions.
- In advance, **teachers** will:
 - Demonstrate their expectations regarding participation and deadlines for Flexible Learning Day
 - Make sure students are aware of how to use Google Classroom and the features associated with it

What Will Teachers Do?

- KEEP IN MIND...
 - Not every teacher will do things the same way!
 - Some might have their assignment due at 11:59 pm on the same day the assignment was assigned.
 - Others might have it due the next day when you get into class.
- Pay attention to to the announcements from your teachers and the deadlines for their assignments!

What Will Students Do?

- On a Flexible Learning Day, **students** will:
 - Access their class on Google Classroom
 - Complete Flexible Learning assignments/activities
 - Communicate questions for teachers via email between 10:00am-3:00pm
- In advance, **students** will:
 - Demonstrate understanding of a teacher's expectations regarding participation and deadlines for Flexible Learning Day
 - Demonstrate understanding of how to use Google Classroom and the features associated with it

What Will Students Do?

- By completing or showing progress on assignments, students will be **marked Present on attendance**.
- If students do NOT complete or show progress on assignments, or make arrangements with their teacher, they will be **marked Absent Unexcused on attendance**.
- If a student is **having trouble with their internet**, they need to communicate with their teachers immediately via email or voicemail to their work phone!

How Will You Get this Info?

- Parents and students will receive written information regarding flexible learning days and have an opportunity to ask teachers questions at Conferences.
- Expectations will be posted on the District website. This may include a video demonstrating the process.
- An explanation of the purpose and vision of Flexible Learning days will be printed in the District newsletter
- Families and community will be informed that a Flexible Learning Day is being implemented via the District instant alert system, the District website, and local news media.
- Classroom teachers will contact parents/students by 10:00am with special instructions for the day.
