Levels of Competition

Junior High

Educational activities that allow each student athlete to learn and develop the basic skills of that activity. Balance amount of time with each athlete. Development emphasized over winning.

C-Squad

Developmental process to understand and prepare each athlete for a Senior High Activity—will try to play each participant, but equal playing time is not guaranteed. Development emphasized over winning.

B-Squad

Prepare athlete to compete at the varsity level. Develop skills and learn process of winning (not winning at all costs). Not equal playing time.

Varsity

The best athletes from grade 9-12 make up the team (younger athletes must be cleared by a "moving up" process). Goal is to compete for the conference, section and state championships. Coaches determine athletes' readiness (not winning at all cost). Not equal playing time.
