

FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITIES FOR ST. CLAIR DAYS 2022!

The St. Clair Days Planning Committee has been busy planning our annual celebration of St. Clair Days. The dates this year are Friday, June 24th and Saturday, June 25th. We do have several fundraising opportunities available.

Parade and Special Event Signs

This opportunity pays \$150. It involves putting up Special Event • No Parking signs along the parade route and several streets lining Memorial Park on Miller Lane on Friday, June 24th. The signs will also need to be removed and boxed up on Sunday morning. There are also a few orange cones that need to be placed along the parade line up area. This is typically completed by a small group of people on a golf cart.

Parade Clean Up

This opportunity pays \$200. Participants are asked to walk the parade route and pick up leftover trash from the street and sidewalk. They are also asked to pick up candy that was run over by vehicles and/or left in the street. Typically a handful of people walk the route together after traffic has subsided from Turtle Races and Pedal Pulls. In the past this has been completed as the sun begins to go down and the weather starts to cool off. Garbage bags and gloves will be provided. Garbage can be disposed of at the dumpsters at City Hall or Memorial Park. Copy of parade route will also be provided.

Concert Clean Up

This opportunity pays \$150. Participants are asked to meet on Sunday, June 26th in the morning to pick up any trash left behind from the Beer Garden and Live Music in the park. Location is Memorial Park on Miller Lane on the baseball field. Garbage bags and gloves will be provided. Garbage can be disposed of at the dumpster located at the park.

Concessions

This opportunity is not paid for by the St. Clair Days Planning Committee, but potential for profits made by your group. Groups could sell concessions during the following times:

1. Friday, June 24th during an outdoor movie on the football field from 8:30pm-10:30pm.
2. Saturday, June 25th during six Youth Baseball Community Education games. This could be held at the school Athletic Backers outdoor red shed. Simple concessions would be needed here, beverage and snacks. The Fire Department will be hosting a Pancake Breakfast in the school commons, so no food such as hot dogs or pizza would be needed. 9:30am-2pm.
3. Saturday, June 25th during the Turtle Races and Pedal Pull. Approximately 4pm-6pm. In previous years beverages, hot dogs and kid friendly fare have been sold.

In addition to the opportunities listed above organizations are welcome to bring forward to the Committee any additional ideas they would like to try.
