



## Daily Health Screening for Parents and Students

### Daily health screening add-on for AS Mobile (Android)

We created a Daily health screening add-on for our AS Mobile app. Simply go to your app store search for rSchoolToday, and download the app with the blue cap logo.


Open the app, click on **GO**, select your State and look up your school name.

Now, open the menu and click on **Daily Health Screening**.



The first time you want to fill out the form, the system will ask you to sign in with your email, with Google or with Microsoft. The system will then ask you to complete your email, name and password, and then **Save**. Then you need to click **Verify**, so that the system sends a confirmation email with a link for you to accept.





Next time you sign in (with a verified email address), you can choose between the available profiles for that email address (in case there is more than one student listed related to that email address).




Once you verify your email address, you can login and begin with the screening.

Simply toggle on for any yes answer to the questions.



Clicking **Profile** will show a history of all previous submissions and enable to set a daily reminder. If you are a parent with multiple students in the school, you can select a different student and then proceed to fill out the form again.
