• Secretary's Report

Motion to accept report-Mike Norman, Second Bernie Cieplicki seconded- Passed unanimously.

• Treasurer's Report

Bob Hingston

Handed out information and stated that things are going well. The golf tournament this past summer was a success.

Motion to accept report-Dan Shepardson, Second David Marlow- Passed unanimously.

• Executive Director's Report

- o Meeting coming up in regards to safety concerns for schools. If you attend materials will be provided to you for use at your schools.
- o Stated that people looking to see what the differences are throughout the nation in regards to liability insurance for Athletic Directors/Administrators.
- Discussion directed towards Executive Board and VPA about if we should have certain requirements for Athletic Directors. Currently, there is a push for such requirements at the national level.
- O The National Conference is December 9-14th at the Gaylord Hotel this year in Nashville, TN. Flights out of Manchester, NH have been found at \$280 round trip right now, and \$350 out of Burlington, VT. This is extremely worthwhile, and you should try to get your administration to support this. There is a scholarship available. You must be have been an ad for at least 1 year.

• Activities Standard Report

Kim Maniery/Ed Hockenbury

- O Sean Farrell will reach out to Dan Marlow in regards to filling Ed Hockenbury's position. Pat Merriam has expressed interest in supporting the state in this role as well.
- O Kim Maniery: At the last meeting there were two hardship waivers addressed. Also discussed was moving golf from the Spring to the Fall season, and eligibility for 5 years (this will take away from our ability to submit a hardship waiver). Next meeting in Nov, will report afterwards.

• VPA Report

Bob Johnson

- o Golf, there has been a movement to move golf from Spring to the Fall season. This has been supported by multiple associations, coaches and schools. VT is the only state around itself that doesn't have golf in the fall. Currently there are only two New England state play golf in the spring, VT and CT. The initial concern was that past attempts were not well received by our golf courses, and that they would not support such a move. That now seems not to be the case. ASC is supportive of this. Adjustments may happen if approved (i.e. limiting the number of holes during the week), and possible elimination of sectionals (in its place would be 4 championship dates). Bernie Cieplicki- what date would be the championship weekend? Bob Johnson-we would look to have championships, at the latest, the 2nd week in October. Dan Shepardson- with the elimination of sectionals, can the courses handle that many teams for the championship? Bob Johnson- this would be a non-issue. With only a few more teams to add. If it goes through (ASC will address this move in November) we will still Golf in the Spring this year, but would turn around and have it in the Fall for 2017.
- o 4 years in 5. Bob Johnson- This is all about 4 years of eligibility in 5 years/modified. In grade 9 the clock starts clicking, and the expectation is that you graduate in the next 4 years. This helps ASC, because it takes most hardship requests off of their plate. There are currently 20 states that do this nationally. TJ Powers- how does this affect 8th grade students? Bob Johnson- This doesn't, and that policy will stay the same. Sean Farrell- If this becomes VPA policy, it will take away our ability as schools to say no? Bob Johnson- more definition to come. Sean Farrell- this policy, will it protect us from people working the system to get another year. Bob Johnson-every situation could be different, but we have seen very few cases of that being attempted. Sean Farrell- I have had many cases where kids tried to come back and have a 13th year. Does this policy protect us from those situations? Bob Johnson- I believe it does. Sean Farrell- is this etched in stone, or are you looking for feedback from us. Bob Johnson-No, this is just information to pass along to you, but there will be a time after more discussion to get

- your feedback. Motion to take a straw vote-Mike Norman, Second Bernie Cieplicki seconded- 37 for and 12 opposed.
- o Game day information about cheerleading, you all have the information. If you need more please contact South Burlington.
- o Reminder that alignments are this year.

• Leadership Conference Melba Masse / Dan Marlow

Tuesday will have two speakers instead of just one. The plan is that the fee will remain the same(\$130 per athlete, \$120 per adult). Athletes will be allowed to swim this year. Please make sure that the students are aware that their rooms will not be available right away. Please also remind them that they have to follow the schedule. Devin Wendell- I think that if you send kids to this you should have an adult repsentative/facilitator there from your school? Sean Farrell-are you still looking for help with schools donating drinks. Melba Masse- yes, and as well hoping to get the same donations from the previous year. Sean Farrell- if you could go to your boosters for support with donations that would be great. Melba Masse- for the scholarship committee, we also need to get information in asap. Geri Witalec-the scholarship committee will recognize up to 10 outstanding student/community/athletic students. From those 1 male/1 female will go into compete in section 1, then from that 1 male and 1 female will go to national contest.
